How do I contact Bird Construction's investor relations department?

On what stock exchange does Bird Construction's shares trade on?

Bird Construction trades on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX).

What is Bird Construction's stock ticker?

Bird Construction's ticker symbol on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX) is BDT.

How long has Bird Construction been a public company?

Bird Construction first went public on the Winnipeg Stock Exchange in 1949.

Does Bird Construction pay dividends?

At this time, Bird Construction pays a monthly dividend in the amount of \$0.0325 per common share.

Does Bird Construction have a direct share repurchase program?

Bird Construction does not have a program to repurchase shares from shareholders at this time.

When is Bird Construction's year end?

Bird Construction's year end is December 31. As such, Bird Construction's quarters are March 31 (Q1), June 30 (Q2) and September 30 (Q3).

Who is Bird Construction's external auditors?

Bird Construction's external auditor is KPMG LLP.

What is a transfer agent?

A transfer agent and registrar for a publicly held company is responsible for keeping a record of every outstanding share certificate including the name of the person to whom it is registered. This information provides the issuing company (Bird Construction) with the shareholder information needed to pay out dividends. When registered stock changes hands, the transfer agent transfers the ownership of the stock from the seller's name to the buyer's name.

Who is Bird Construction's transfer agent and how can I contact them?

Bird Construction's transfer agent is Computershare Investor Services.
